Program Level	Graduate
Do I need a valid Ohio teaching License to be eligible for the program?	Yes
How long is the program?	4 semesters (Summer, Fall, Spring, Summer)
How many credit hours of coursework are required?	22 graduate hours 12 hours of reading (if not completed previously)
Reading Requirement for Licensure	12 semester hours including 3 hours of Phonics
What is the licensure or certification test?	OAE 045 If reading core not completed previously – OAE 090
What are the field and internship/practicum minimum requirements? **All field and practicum are face to face	Field – 50 hours Supervised Practicum – 80 hours
When will I complete the field hours and internship?	Field hours - throughout the 1 st 3 semesters Practicum – final summer



What license/certificate will I apply for upon program completion?	Intervention Specialist: Visually Impaired preK-12
How is the coursework delivered?	Hybrid (online & face to face) Mandatory Weekend sessions – 1 per semester
Is there tuition support?	Yes – full tuition + books and materials
Is there a service agreement upon completion?	Yes – 3 years serving children with visual impairments in Ohio Public Schools
