If you currently teach or are planning to teach high school Advanced Placement classes, register now for Shawnee State University's AP Summer Institute. The AP Summer Institutes are subject-specific professional development opportunities that provide teachers with the support and training needed to teach AP courses and to utilize Pre-AP teaching strategies.

Workshops planned for 2009 are: **AP English Literature and Composition, AP Government and Politics: United States, and AP Statistics.** There is space available for thirty participants per workshop. Workshops will be held Monday through Friday on campus from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Continental breakfast and lunch will be available daily.

Registration Information

You may register on-line, by mail or in person. Registration is accepted on a first-come first-served basis. For our inaugural year, registration fees for Ohio teachers have been drastically reduced, thanks to grants from the Ohio Dept of Education, the Scioto Foundation, and the Ohio South Tech Prep Consortium.

Credit

The AP Summer Institute provides two credit options for participants completing the Institute. CEU credits and a Continuing Education Certificate of Completion will be provided by the College Board Graduate Workshop. Graduate credit is available through Ohio University Southern Campus, for an additional fee. Individuals may purchase up to three graduate workshop hours @ \$160.00 per credit hour. Indicate the number of hours requested on the registration form to obtain a graduate credit registration packet.

The Workshops

Topics that are often covered in summer institute sessions include:

- ◆ AP courses: goals, objectives, content, resources, bibliographies, and equipment
- ◆ The AP Examination: how it is developed and graded
- ◆ Syllabi, lesson plans, and assignments
- ◆ How to refresh and improve existing AP courses
- ◆ Recent changes in AP course descriptions
- ◆ Strategies for teaching students at beginning or intermediate levels
- ◆ Vertical teaming

Participants will receive hand-outs and other materials for use in their AP classrooms, as well as valuable networking connections with other teachers and expert consultants.



Daily Schedule

The APSI week is intense and the consultants cover an enormous amount of material in a very short amount of time. In order to be fully prepared to teach AP courses, participants will be required to attend every session (all 32 hours of instruction). Full participation is required in order to complete the Institute or to receive the graduate workshop credit .
