

#### **Emergency Procedures**


- Emergency Evacuation and Procedures Posted in Residence Halls

# **Parking on Campus**

- > Parking Permits are required for <u>all</u> Staff, Faculty & Students
- No charge for Parking Permits
- Parking Areas are designated for:
  - Campus Housing Residents
  - Commuter Students
  - Staff & Visitors
- > Permits do not guarantee a parking space
  - May have to walk from overflow lots during peak parking hours
- **Enforcement:** 
  - Citations & Fines Issued for violations of University Parking Policy
  - Holds are placed against Student ID until paid
