- Do not pay to have the FAFSA filed. It is free!!

Create a New FSA ID

An FSA ID gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature.

Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use. You are not authorized to create an FSA ID on behalf of someone else, including a family member. Misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government could result in criminal or civil penalties.

To create your own personal FSA ID, enter answers for the questions below and select CONTINUE.

Important: When you are done click the CANCEL button to clear your data, even if you did not finish creating your FSA ID. Step 2 Verification

- Students selected by the U.S. Department of Education
- Submit tax return transcripts, W2 forms, worksheets, etc.
- View needed documents on MySSU Financial Aid Tab
- SSU must complete verification process-federal requirement



Step 3 Review Financial Aid Awards

- Financial Aid will create awards for each student
- Includes federal and state aid for which student is eligible
 - Grants (if eligible)
 - Loans
 - Scholarships, etc.



Step 4 Accept Student Loans

- Student loan funds are accepted through MySSU
 Click on the following:
 - Financial Aid Tab
 - Select the appropriate year in the drop down box in the Financial Aid Awards box
 - View Financial Aid Award
 - Accept/Decline Aid link and follow instructions

Step 7 Complete Financial Aid Authorization

- Required to be able to use financial aid in the SSU bookstore to purchase (charge) books or to cover any miscellaneous fees
- Located on the Financial Aid Tab of MySSU
 - Click on the following:
 - Financial Aid Tab
 - Complete SSU Financial Aid Authorization in the SSU Financial Aid Authorization Box
 - Choose Appropriate Selection
 - Submit



Bookstore Charges

- Complete the Financial Aid Authorization to charge books
- Students with a credit balance are able to charge books against their financial aid
 - Negative number = credit balance
 - Positive number = money owed to SSU
- Bookstore charges begin 2 weeks prior to the beginning of the term
 - Fall semester dates: August 13 through August 31



Special Circumstances

- Changes in income since 2016
 - Loss of income
 - Changes in marital status
 - Paid medical bills not covered by insurance
 - Parent in college
- Special Condition application located on the Financial Aid webpage and MySSU



Using Aid for Summer Semester

- Financial Aid is awarded for fall and spring
- Student may request aid for summer semester
 - Request for Change in Distribution Form
 - Federal Direct Loan Change Request Form



Important Reminders

- Submit final high school transcript with graduation date
- Students should check their MySSU account and email regularly



Payment Due Dates

If student has a remaining balance for fall semester after financial aid is applied, payment is due on the following dates:

August 1 - 1/4 of balance due by 4:30 p.m.

September 5 - 1/3 of remaining balance due by 4:30 p.m.

October 3 - 1/2 of remaining balance due by 4:30 p.m.

November 7 – remaining balance due by 4:30 p.m.



BankMobile

- Students will receive a package from BankMobile- DO NOT TRASH!
- Log onto the BankMobile site using their personal code included in the packet
- Select refund preference
 - Direct deposit into personal bank account
 - BankMobile Vibe Account



Information Release

- Student completes online through MySSU
 - Click on the following:
 - Student Tab
 - SSU Student FERPA Release (left side of screen)
 - Add New Record
 - Enter Information and click Add New Record
- Student should give passphrase to anyone they grant access



Scholarships

- Outside scholarships- may require proof of enrollment
- May have restrictions on what they can be used for
