

SSU SPIRIT ROCK

The SSU Spirit Rock tradition is an opportunity to demonstrate SSU spirit for various campus events, offices and student groups/organizations. The SSU Spirit Rock is located in the grassy area north of the Townhouses. **Although approval may be given to paint the SSU Spirit Rock, windy or inclement weather conditions may require the cancellation of the event.** Requests for painting the SSU Spirit Rock must be made at least **five business days in advance** provided the SSU Spirit Rock is available during the time requested. All requests will be approved on a first come, first serve basis and email confirmation will be sent to the responsible party.

GUIDELINES

1. The SSU Spirit Rock can be painted by only one group, organization or individual student per day.
2. The SSU Spirit Rock may be reserved for a maximum of three days.
3. The group or organization painting the SSU Spirit Rock assumes liability for any individual or member of the group/organization who may be injured or may incur clothing damage.
4. Groups/organizations must furnish their own paint and supplies to paint the SSU Spirit Rock. **All paint used must be latex paint ONLY.**
5. **ONLY** the SSU Spirit Rock can be painted. Painting on sidewalks, lampposts, grass, or buildings is not permitted; otherwise, the group/organization will be held financially responsible for cleaning costs and any other violations to the Student Conduct Code.
6. All things painted on the SSU Spirit Rock must be in good taste. Anything profane or obscene is not permitted. What is painted reflects on you and your group/organization. In the case that anything profane or obscene is painted, the organization will be required to paint over it immediately or the organization and/or responsible person may face consequences through the student conduct system or loss of privileges.
7. The SSU Spirit Rock may be reserved for painting daily between 8am – 9:30pm or sunset (*whatever comes later*).
8. No alcohol or controlled substance(s) at SSU Spirit Rock Painting.
9. No horseplay around or climbing on the SSU Spirit Rock.
10. Follow all University Student Conduct Code Policies.

This is a wonderful way to demonstrate spirit at SSU! Please keep in mind that safety comes first!
